The proficiency level "below level 1" is the lowest level and "level 5" is the highest proficiency level. If they can perform the most complex tasks, they are rated as having proficient skill. Only 12% of U.S. adults scored in the highest literacy proficiency levels, and only 9% scored in the highest numeracy levels.

Individuals at the lowest literacy and numeracy levels have a higher rate of unemployment and earn lower wages than the national average. Low literacy costs the U.S. at least \$225 billion each year in non-productivity in the workforce, crime, and loss of tax revenue due to unemployment.<sup>4</sup>
