Under section 1.3 of Legal Aid Queensland's practice management standards preferred supplier's must ensure that there is no conflict of interest when requesting or accepting a grant of aid. If a solicitor acts for a client where they have a conflict of interest the solicitor may be subject to disciplinary proceedings.

A conflict of interest is defined in Principle 7.02 (Conflict of Interest between Solicitor and Client) and in Principle 9.01 (Avoiding Conflict). There is a conflict of interests if: a solicitor or the firm owes separate duties to act in the best interests of two or more clients in relation to the same or related matters, and those duties conflict, or there is a significant risk that those ...
