It's the written record of an original classification decision or series of decisions regarding a system, plan, program, or project. The SCG addresses each Critical Program Information (CPI), as well as other relevant information requiring protection, including export-controlled information and sensitive but unclassified ...

Classifying General Schedule Positions

For Official Use Only (FOUO) is a document designation, not a classification. This designation is used by Department of Defense and a number of other federal agencies to identify information or material which, although unclassified, may not be appropriate for public release.

The third method for communicating a classification decision is the DD Form 254, the DoD Contract Security Classification Specification. This form is a contract document which officially and legally conveys classification guidance to a cleared contractor. It binds the contractor to meet that classification guidance.

Security classification guidance required for derivative classification is identified in block 13 of the DD Form 254. However, source documents such as the security classification guide itself sometimes are attached to the DD Form 254.
