Hazchem (/ ' h æ z k e m /; from hazardous chemicals) is a warning plate system used in Australia, Malaysia, New Zealand, India and the United Kingdom for vehicles transporting hazardous substances, and on storage facilities. The top-left section of the plate gives the Emergency Action Code (EAC) telling the fire brigade what actions to take if there's an accident or fire.

Cracking the ABC Code

(emergency action code; EAC) A code designed to be displayed when hazardous chemicals are transported or stored in bulk. It is used to help the emergency services to take action quickly in any accident. The code consists of a number followed by one or two letters. The number indicates the type of substance to be used in treating the accident (e.g. stream of water, fine spray, foam, dry agent).

Cracking the Code - The Redemption Service

Under ADR a hazard warning placard must be 250 x 250mm in size. The surrounding black border must be 5mm in width and spaced 12.5mm from the placard edge. Similarly, where a substance is packaged in a quantity greater than its limited quantity a 100 x 100mm UN warning label is required. A label must have a border of thickness no less than 2mm spaced 5mm from the diamond edge.
