Foundation Phase Framework - Hwb

The Foundation Phase is the statutory curriculum for all 3 to 7 year olds in Wales. It encourages children to use their imaginations and to be creative, making learning fun and more effective. Children are given opportunities to explore the world around them and understand how things work by taking part in practical activities relevant to their developmental stage.
