The main part of the book - "Life on Earth" - lays out and catalogues the rich story of life, from its

beginnings 4 billion years ago, through each geological period, such as the Jurassic and Cretaceous, to the present. The stunning visuals and authoritative text make *Dinosaurs and Prehistoric Life* a fascinating and revealing encyclopedia that will appeal to the whole family.
