Architects of Annihilation follows the activities of the demographers, economists, geographers and planners in the period between the disorderly excesses of the November 1938 pogrom and the fully-effective operation of the gas chambers at Auschwitz in summer 1942. academic, civil service and Party functions, made an indispensable contribution to the planning and execution of the Final Solution.
