Au coin d'une rue, une femme peinte sur le mur braque sur vous son regard équivoque. A quelques pas, sur une façade entre deux immeubles, une porte s'ouvre sur la forêt vierge. Plus loin, un poteau est gainé de laine multicolore... Est-ce que quelque chose ne tourne pas rond ? Au contraire, la ville crépite de toutes les voix des artistes qui l'arparent, de nuit comme de jour, pour lui offrir leurs plus belles oeuvres. Leur possibilité d'expression est considérable, et leur terrain de jeu gigantesque. Vous trouverez dans ces pages tous les procédés actuels du street art (pochoir, poster, collage, peinture, détournement publicitaire, installation, mosaïque, tricot...), décrits par ses figures majeures. Des street artists des quatre coins du monde, qui ont fait de la rue leur galerie et de vous leur public - ou disciple -, y présentent leurs travaux, témoignent de leur pratique et vous donnent des conseils pour se lancer. Entre manuel technique, livre d'artiste et

Gravure et impression fait entrer le profane dans l'univers mystérieux du graveur d'art avec ses outils très spécialisés, ses machines énormes et ses matériaux qui tiennent de l'alchimie pour le non-initié. L'impression rend possible la reproduction en série d'un dessin ou d'une peinture tout en les réinterprétant et en créant des effets visuels particuliers. Les aplats de couleur d'une linogravure ou d'une sérigraphie seraient en effet difficiles à obtenir avec un simple pinceau. En lithographie, le grain, la texture du tracé et l'effet de lavis expriment une sensibilité totalement différente de la peinture. L'eau-forte forme un système à elle seule : un trait gravé n'est pas un trait dessiné. Certains de ces procédés sont faciles à mettre en œuvre, et ne demandent qu'un matériel simple. Même les plus élaborés peuvent s'apprendre de façon progressive. Les nombreuses techniques proposées sont illustrées étape par étape. Ainsi, le débutant gagne en assurance, réussit ses projets et découvre que les contraintes techniques peuvent stimuler la créativité au lieu de la brider. La grande variété des œuvres reproduites ouvre le lecteur à diverses façons d'interpréter une image, à tirer parti du trait et de la couleur, à créer motifs et textures pour composer une ambiance, une atmosphère. Gravure et impression est l'œuvre d'artistes inventifs et passionnés. Laissez-vous prendre dans ce dynamisme de création et faites confiance à votre talent.
