The Malice of Herodotus can perhaps best be described as the world's earliest known book review. But it is much more than that, for in the course of 'correcting' with considerable vituperation what he saw as Herodotus' anti-Greek bias, Plutarch tells us much about his own attitude to writing history. So that together with Lucian's How to Write History (see Lucian A Selection in this series) it forms a basic text for the study of Greek historiography. It is also perhaps the most revealing example of Plutarch's prose style with its rhetorical variety and energy and odd mixture of good and bad argument. But in citing lost works, Plutarch has preserved valuable fragments which don't exist elsewhere and need to be assessed by all students of the Persian Wars. Preaching is a method of exhorting the practice of virtues and the performance of one's duties. If people are not moved to act, preachers become obsolete. The main reason that led the Authors to write the further *Electrical Circuit* book is mainly due to request of their students to have an ordered collection of the lesson arguments. The topics covered by the book are those generally carried out in the first or second year of bachelor, without referring specifically to a specific engineering course. The Authors have tried to deal with the various topics in a simple way, sometimes by limiting the generality of the demonstrations, in order to increase the skills of the student in the application of the electrical circuit theory. At the same time the Authors have not limited the complexity of the matter but have tried to present in a fairly complete way the various components, the various behaviours and methods of solution. For Nietzsche, the Age of Greek Tragedy was indeed a tragic age. He saw in it the rise and climax of values so dear to him that their subsequent drop into catastrophe (in the person of Socrates - Plato) was clearly foreshadowed as though these were events taking place in the theater. And so in this work, unpublished in his own day but written at the same time that his *The Birth of Tragedy* had so outraged the German professorate as to imperil his own academic career, his most deeply felt task was one of education. He wanted to present the culture of the Greeks as a paradigm to his young German contemporaries who might thus be persuaded to work toward a state of culture of their own; a state where Nietzsche found sorely missing.
