The designs cover a variety of themes, including flowers and cacti, gardens, birds and butterflies, seaside motifs, tropical motifs, and animals. The designs are colorful and pretty and will take crafters no time at all to stitch!

In the 21st century however there has been a steep resurgence and many are turning to crafting, especially needlework, as an activist strategy. In *Knitting for Good*, feminist Betsy Greer makes this point strongly when she proclaims, "I think every act of making is an act of revolution."
