The form class is the level of representation and the People class is the middle level. You will add controls to the form so people can enter ID, last name, and their height. When the user clicks the Save button, the code will assign input values ??to the People class properties.

Finally, you will display the People object on a label. Figure below shows the form after the user clicks the Save button. Your task here is to write an object-oriented application so that training manager can display and edit the training services offered.
