THE SHOFAR, or trumpet of ram's horn, has often been mentioned among the symbols appearing in the Jewish remains we are studying.¹ In Jewish ritual the straight horn of the wild goat was at one time used interchangeably with the curved horn of the ram, but by Greco-Roman times the goat's horn was generally superseded by the ram's horn, which is the shofar of the monuments.
