FACT: Automatics are better for off-road racing. Virtually no off-road racing discipline - from Trophy Trucks to Ultra4 cars to cone dodging rockcrawling buggies - uses manual transmissions. The exception would be limited classes such as Class 10 where lower horsepower favor the use of manuals, or they are specifically required (as in the case of Class 11).
