Teach comprehension first. Skills like phonics can be developed after meaning is established or receptive and expressive vocabulary is strong. Plan comprehension-building activities before, during, and after the reading, such as picture walks (looking at and discussing the pictures in a book before reading to build background) and writing a personal response.

To teach reading, start by teaching the child the alphabet using songs or by showing the them the letters in their name. Once they know letter names, show them the sound each one makes and give examples of words that start with each letter.
