### The Care Homes Regulations 2001

These Regulations are made under the Care Standards Act 2000 ("the Act") and apply to England only. Part I of the Act establishes, in relation to England, the National Care Standards Commission ("the Commission") and Part II provides for the registration and inspection of establishments and agencies, including care homes, by the Commission.

New Jersey State regulations, called rules, implement the statutes that are the legal basis for operating State programs and services. Rules utilized by the Department of Human Services are codified at Title 10 of the New Jersey Administrative Code.

### Current Administrative Rules and Regulations

The main aim of the Regulation of Care (Scotland) Act 2001 is to improve standards of social care services. The Act meant that far more care services and staff came under scrutiny and had to conform to established standards. Failure of a care service or an individual to comply with the Act and associated regulations means they can be de-registered and no longer able to provide services.

### Care homes for older people : national minimum standards ...

Adult care homes vary in size from family care homes with 2-6 residents to adult care homes with more than 100 residents Adult care homes are licensed by the state Division of Health Service Regulation (DHSR) under state regulations and are monitored by Adult Home Specialists within local Departments of Social Services .
