Fool, Foolishness, Folly. TheOld Testament. Several Hebrew words are rendered "fool," with nuances ranging all the way from the naive but teachable person (Prov 14:15 — peti [1], derived from the Hebrew root meaning "open," hence impressionable) to the hopelessly incorrigible person who deserves no corrective efforts since such will be in vain (Prov 26:3 kesil [1]).
